On behalf of Merck Sharp & Dohme Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of Merck & Co., Inc. (the "Company"), this letter is intended to serve as the required Notice to each of you under the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), 29 U.S.C. § 2101, et. seq., of the anticipated closure of the Company's site of employment located at 13900 NW 57th Ct, Miami Lakes, FL 33014.
